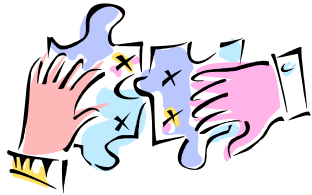

- I. Meeting called to order at 4:05 by Susan Woodford
- II. Introductions were made
- III. Minutes were reviewed and approved by Susan Clark, seconded by Dr. Johnson
- IV. Business: Susan announced that the December meeting is cancelled because it is so close to Christmas.

Nick discussed the new Youth Coalition at Yulee High School and said it is going well so far and he likes the initiative the class is taking. They have already created surveys and plan on interviewing the Dean. Also, they are going to start on their logic model this week. Susan explained that the students at Yulee have identified transportation as an issue and that there is nothing for them to do. The students in Fernandina seem to agree because they also say that they have nothing to do. One of the Fernandina classes chose age discrimination as their issue but after interviewing the principal they decided to change their topic. Through their interview with the principal we found a huge communication gap between the administration and students so a dialogue has been started.

Dr. Johnson's presentation has been moved to the next meeting.

V. Reports on Enforcement:

David Williams, NCSO, reported 4 tobacco citations at Callahan Middle School. Susan brought to his attention that there have been reports on higher uses of K2 in middle schools on the West side.

VI. Reports from Members:

Jennifer Emmons, NCHD, reported that the SWAT students have been very busy, they were at Relay for Life and the Callahan Fair. They are also starting a petition to get rid of the candy flavored tobacco, there are currently 34 flavors sold in our county. SWAT has also been out educating the adults in our community.

Dr. Seidel, NCHD, announced that the Health Department is looking for volunteers to participate in the planning for **MAPP** (Mobilizing for Action through Planning and Partnership) this process should last about a year and a half.

Susan Woodford, reported on our website updates and how we are very pleased with the company we chose and suggested everyone use Nassau Web Design if they need help with their website.

Laureen Pagel, SPBH, said they are implementing an evidence-based program for adolescents for mental health, substance abuse, or trauma at no charge. This program is called SPARK and it started this week. Laureen went over possible slogans for promoting prevention in the state of Florida, everyone voted and chose "Prevention today for a healthy tomorrow," because it was more positive. Laureen then announced that Sutton Place is fully staffed.

Susan Woodford, said that we submitted our Call to Action, which is a 6 month contract with the state of Florida through DCF. Currently we are negotiating with FSU and our coach has changed to either Dr. Waters or **Cindy Grant**. The community policing is continuing with support from the Sheriff. We are waiting on the city magistrate hearing to move forward with our social host ordinances. Susan then announced we are conducting surveys to gather adult data for the 18-24 year old population. We will be doing surveys at FSCJ, Winn Dixie in Callahan, and the movie theater. Susan then reported on the new FYSAS data and explained that almost

everything has gone down in alcohol except 11th and 12th grader past 30 day use and kids are reporting that parents approve of underage drinking.

Susan and Kerrie have been speaking at various organizations most recent they presented at the Bryceville Community Meeting, the Rotary Club, and Optimist Club. They have been invited to speak at the Kiwanis Club. Also, Susan visited the Journey Church and reported that they have about 300 kids every Wednesday night. Susan and Kerrie have presented the new school board policy and are just waiting to hear back from Dr. Ruis.
